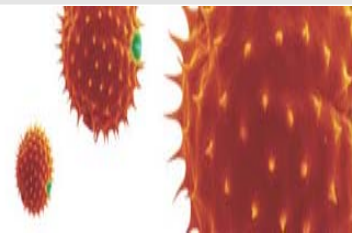

Conference aim

The 2009 Pharmaceutical Translational Research Conference, organised by the London School of Pharmacy in partnership with the NIHR Medicines for Children Research Network (MCRN), aims to aid participants in understanding the relevance of pharmaceutical research and how this can be translated into clinical studies.

Call for posters

The conference organisers are pleased to invite submission of abstracts for poster presentation at the conference. Posters are required in two categories relating to research in paediatric formulations, experimental medicine, pharmacokinetics and pharmacogenomics.

These categories are as follows:

- ◆ Category one: Ongoing or recently completed research
- ◆ Category two: New research ideas

Abstracts must conform to the following requirements:

- ◆ Include a short title (up to 20 words)
- ◆ Maximum length: 250 words
- ◆ Structure: background, objectives, methods, results and implications
- ◆ Include author's contact details including institution, address, email, telephone and fax number(s)
- ◆ Submit your abstract electronically to laura.pilkington@liverpool.ac.uk
- ◆ Closing date: 31st January 2009.

All abstracts will be reviewed and successful entries will be invited to display a poster at the conference. Authors will be advised in writing of acceptance or non-acceptance of abstracts towards the end of February 2009.

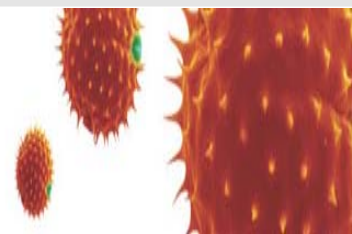

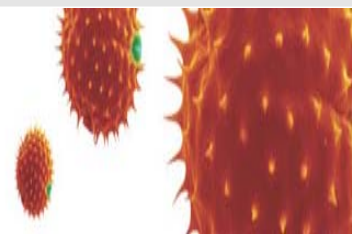

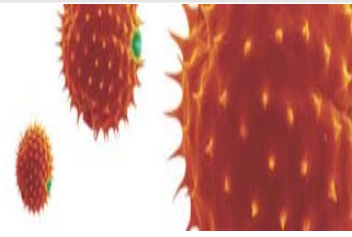
