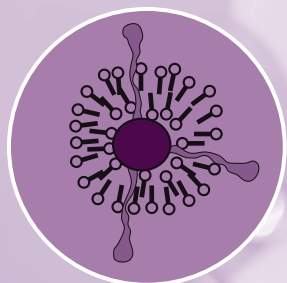

Authors should indicate on the reply form whether they prefer oral or poster presentation. Proposals are also invited for panel discussions and special workshops.
