Poster presentations will be at the heart of this year's symposium. We have scheduled two poster viewing times (45 min and 30 min duration; see programme on previous page) giving students lots of time to not only read and discuss the posters, but also to help choose the posters worthy of prize awards.

Posters at the symposium can be on any aspect of pharmaceuticals/drug delivery/controlled release. A single page abstract (Word or pdf format) should be submitted by **7 March 2014** using the submission facility on the [symposium page](#) of the UKICRS website. As always, please ensure that you have the approval of your supervisor(s) before submitting an abstract.

Eleven abstract submissions made by postgraduate students will be selected by the UKICRS committee for 15 min oral presentations (see programme on previous page). Students whose abstracts have been selected for oral presentation will receive email notification by **14 March 2014**.

Abstracts must be 300 words or less (no figures or tables) and adhere to the following formatting requirements:

- *Arial font, size 11, single line spacing throughout*
- *Title should be **BOLD CAPITALS** and then followed by the author(s) and affiliation on the line below*
- *Underline the name of the presenting (attending) author*

The 300 word limit does **not** include the title, author(s) and affiliation. All abstracts will be included both on the UKICRS website and in the hard-copy symposium booklet.

A template Word document is provided on the [symposium page](#) of the UKICRS website. Please use the template!

Posters should be designed in portrait format for display on poster boards (width 87 cm x height 117 cm).

Abstract Submission

Registration and payment for attendance at the UKICRS 2014 Symposium can be made in three easy steps ...
